### Please read the following carefully before submitting your application:

- Selected Artists will spend either Saturday (1-5pm) or Sunday (12pm 4pm) during the festival demonstrating their art or craft and interacting with the public.
- Participating artists will receive an honorarium to-be-discussed upon acceptance
- Participating artist will be provided with breakfast, lunch and snacks throughout the festival
- Each Artist will be provided with a table and chair in the Demo Tent near the Art Market. Artists should set up in a way that allows them to demonstrate/ interact with/ provide hands on activities for the public.
- You will need to bring all your own supplies and materials. KIAC may be able assist in some cases with small items (i.e. scissors), please mention this when replying with your set up requirements.
- The Demo tent is for demonstration/hand-on activities only. Sales of your artwork can be made by booking a table in the Art Market (please contact admin@kiac.ca to do so).
- Electricity is available if needed but please keep in mind we have a limited amount of power available. Please list your power needs in your set up requirements.

### Regarding hands on activities:

- A small drop-in fee may be charged to recover the cost of materials used by the public. KIAC provides an honorarium to artists for their time, so any charge should be for materials only. Please try to keep fees somewhere under \$10. You are responsible for collecting your own fees and providing your own float, if necessary.
- KIAC suggests that hands-on activities be held on a drop-in basis as some artists in the past have found that people like to 'try' things but not necessarily complete or attend for any length of time. This is part of the interactive festival atmosphere and we'd encourage it.

### **Accommodations**

- Participants are responsible for their own accommodations while visiting Dawson City for the festival.
- There are hotels, B&B's, campgrounds, and RV parks in the Dawson area. The best way to find out information about accommodations is through the Visitor Information Centre @ 867-993-5566. We recommend booking as early as you can, since it is a very busy weekend in Dawson.
